
## Product Information – Portable Gas Detection

Dear MSA Customer,

As previously communicated on 8/23/2022, all ALTAIR 4XR Multigas Detectors produced between April 1, 2022 and August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022 experience a non-safety related performance issue that was caused by a vendor supplied component. This issue causes the battery to rapidly drain when the instrument is off. While not a safety issue, we recognize that it is an inconvenience. Effective immediately, a firmware update is available that will enable the detector to perform as expected.

In order to receive the firmware update, customers are advised to send their instrument to an MSA Service Center or certified channel partner. MSA will cover the cost of the update as well as shipping per our warranty procedure, and the Service Center or channel partner will update the firmware on your instrument(s). Please contact customer service to start this process.


